Arthur Acker DMD

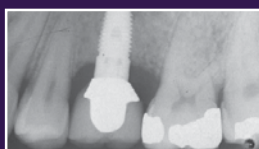

Course Description and Expectations

Learn to predictably treat your patients using dental implants. You will be encouraged to bring cases for review and you will benefit from one-on-one treatment planning. You will learn to use CT guided surgical techniques, participate in hands-on model workshops and observe and place implants in live surgeries. Upon completion of this course you will understand why, when, and how patients can benefit from dental implant treatment.

Participants will be expected to demonstrate competency on all hands-on exercises and quizzes. Each participant will bring cases for treatment planning and review. Live surgeries will be observed or assisted at each session. Observation and assistance in live surgeries are required; dates will be announced at the first session.
