COURSE DESCRIPTION

Esthetics in implant dentistry is in focus today. In the past, a general tendency to mimic/copy teeth with implants was observed both functionally and esthetically. Surgical techniques from oral surgery or periodontology were used in implant surgery however they were esthetically unsuccessful. Hence new incision position, depth, angulations according to the interproximal bone and soft tissue biotype are necessary.

New incision flap designs and suturing techniques have been developed or adjusted to address the esthetic needs around implants and avoid or correct failures in the esthetic zone. Preserving the soft tissue or repairing soft tissue failures around implants will be taught.

 - For GBR
 - For soft tissue improvement
 - For creating keratinized gingiva
 - For gaining soft tissue elasticity


